



# RECORD OF THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING FOR NESTON TUESDAY 20<sup>th</sup> April 2021

In attendance: Eight electors (seven NTC Councillors, and one resident) and Mrs Kunaj (Council Manager)

## 1. Record of the meeting:

## 2. Annual Report from the Town Mayor:

The Town Mayor, Cllr Warner, read out her report covering the activities of the Town, but prior to this, the additional report below was read out:

'On Friday 9<sup>th</sup> April, we learned of the death of Prince Philip. A specific protocol was triggered nationwide and Neston Town played its part. Our flag was lowered to half-mast and remained at half-mast until Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> April. Our website carried the news for our residents. As Mayor of Neston, I attended a memorial service at Chester Cathedral on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> April. On Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> April Neston parish church held its own memorial service which was attended by the Lord-Lieutenant of Chester, our MP, Mr. Justin Madders, the leader of Cheshire West and Chester Council and Councillor for Little Neston, Cllr. Louise Gittins, Cllr. Martin Barker, the Mayor and consort of Ellesmere Port, Neston Town Councillors and representatives of local churches, schools and institutions. It was a dignified acknowledgement of the death of Prince Philip but also a thanksgiving for a long life well lived.'

Cllr Warner expressed her well wishes to her successor and hoped they have a successful year.

## 3. Question Time: Residents were invited to raise questions. None were raised.

Cllr Warner gave thanks to our resident for her attendance and to her fellow councillors and council officers for their help, support and assistance throughout her time as Chair.
