A VIP area for Veterans & Dignitaries
A decorated picnic area for families

2* Arena

An area for displays & drills from local cadets, brownies and marching band etc.
Performance space for local dance troupes & Arts Organisations

3* Performance Stage

Stage set up for local acts, bands, choirs & performers

4* Food/Drink/Crafts Stalls

Local food businesses & eateries, artisans & Craft stalls

5* Family Games Area

Old fashioned games, bubble making & eco arts etc..

6* Civic Hall

Jubilee Bake Off competition, Flower displays, Cafe & Bar

7* 1000 voices

Coordinating and Working with local schools, choirs & community groups to perform one of the Queen's favourite songs on the day of the event.
A vocal leader will deliver singing workshops within the schools to teach the chosen song to participants. This will then be performed on the day of the event to create a 1000 voices.

8* Crafting & Creating Jubilee bunting for the event

Coordinating and working with local crafting groups to create sustainable bunting and decoration for the event.

We will have numerous mentors and volunteers involved who are all local residents, this gives them the opportunity to be part of an event in a professional and structured environment. The spirit of community is so important and our mentors and volunteers are setting great examples to our town to ensure that this spirit continues to grow into the future, thus giving the residents of Neston something to be proud of.
