Subject of Motion

Why this proposal is being made

As part of the Heritage Trail Interpretation Boards project, the Parkgate Society would like to replace the Town Council's Parkgate noticeboard with a new board made of recycled materials and incorporating a map of interesting places to visit in the area. Purchase of the new board will be subject to Parkgate Society raising sufficient funds via Spacehive.

What is being proposed

That we agree to Parkgate Society replacing the notice board in Mostyn Square with a new board made of recycled material for Town Council and Community use. The board will have a lockable side for Town Council use. Removal of the old board and installation of the new board will be included within the cost of the Heritage Interpretation Boards project. Parkgate Society will take responsibility for producing and updating the heritage map on the community side of the board and local groups will still have unrestricted access to add community notices. It is intended that the new board will be located in the same position at the existing board and will be of similar size. The new board to become a Town Council asset.
