Proposed Traffic calming measures in Ness

Cheshire West & Chester Council is proposing to introduce traffic calming measures in Ness following concerns from residents about speeding through the village. NTC is asked to consider some financial support for this initiative by using a proportion of the CIL budget.

Background: Ness is a small village with little private parking so cars are left outside the houses along the Burton Road. Mill Lane, close to the bend by the Wheatsheaf public house, is also used as an alternative route to Lees Lane to reach the A540.

This, combined with several through cars exceeding the speed limit, leads to potentially dangerous situations for both motorists and pedestrians.
