Mayor's Report. Full Council Meeting 25th January 2022. On 27th November the Neston Christmas Lights switch on took place as planned. Many residents commented on how pleased they were to see this event, and they were very pleased to see the Christmas lights in the Town Hall.

I was invited to attend The Little Actors Christmas presentation at Neston Town Hall on 11th December; this was an opportunity to see Neston's junior actors performing. I am very pleased that Little Actors are establishing their base at the Town Hall.

I attended the Christmas Market on 17th December and, together with the deputy Mayor, presented prizes for the most festive stalls. The Market was well attended and I think it was generally considered to have been a great success.

We have made a start with the Councillor Surgeries at Neston Library, and I encourage all Councillors to volunteer to take part.
